2. **DOT (Department of Transportation) Regulations:** Cosmetics are classified as hazardous materials under DOT regulations if they are flammable, corrosive, or otherwise dangerous. Specific packaging and labeling requirements apply.

3. **ICAO (International Civil Aviation Organization) Regulations:** For air transport, cosmetics must comply with ICAO's Dangerous Goods Regulations, which are more stringent than DOT rules.

4. **UN (United Nations) Recommendations:** These provide the international standard for the classification, packaging, and labeling of dangerous goods.

5. **Customs Regulations:** Different countries have varying import and export requirements for cosmetics, including restrictions on certain ingredients.

7. **Insurance:** Given the high value of cosmetics, comprehensive insurance coverage is essential to protect against loss or damage during transit.

8. **Prohibited Materials:** Certain ingredients, such as lithium batteries (found in some beauty devices) and highly flammable liquids, are subject to additional restrictions.

9. **Documentation:** Accurate and complete documentation, including invoices, manifests, and certificates of origin, is vital for smooth customs clearance.
